



IES Antonio Serna Serna has been the holder of ECHE since 2015 and we were granted its renewal for the period 2021-2027.

Our first project was in the 2016 call and since then we have not missed the event any year, requesting, organizing and implementing Erasmus+ projects KA103 and KA131 to training and teaching mobilities of our staff from the Professional Family of Administration and Management, which teaches Higher Education studies, and members of the Management Team.

Our institution is committed to Erasmus+ projects as part of our strategy to continue with its modernization and internationalization process, promoting the spirit of European Citizenship, language learning (English and French), computer and digital skills, ethics and common values and Inclusive Education.

In our center and in the population you can breathe Erasmus+. We have managed to create inertia of participation that has excited the entire educational community (Parents, Students and teachers) and that is why we have seen fit to update our Erasmus Policy Declaration.

Thanks to the Erasmus Charter and the mobility projects of our teachers, friendship ties have been created with other institutions that have allowed us to develop projects in School Education and Vocational Training. As of today (September 2024) we are accredited by our National Agency SEPIE, to organize Erasmus+ projects in three educational areas: Higher Education, Education for Vocational Training and School Education.

To get an idea of the evolution of our participation, in the 2016-2017 academic year there was only one teacher mobility, in the 2017-2018 academic year there was also only one mobility, in the 2018-2019 academic year there were three teacher mobility... In the 2023-2024 academic year, 36 teacher and 54 student mobilities have been carried out with the different Erasmus+ programs that our center has granted.



Our institution has more than 14 years of experience participating in exchange projects with centers in Slovenia and Switzerland and since the 2016-2017 academic year in the Erasmus+ Program of the European Union.

The trajectory and previous experience of IES Antonio Serna are the basis for the modernization of our institution as well as the objective of being part of a European Education Area. We want to continue our participation in the Erasmus program and for next year we have new challenges as Higher Education students will carry out training internships in companies in the European Union (Poland) for the first time. Likewise, Vocational Training students will also carry out training internships in companies in Italy and Slovenia.

IES Antonio Serna is very proud of the group of teachers who are part of "The Erasmus Team", who work to organize and guarantee the inclusion, equity, safety and quality of education and promote learning opportunities for all.

Erasmus+ projects are the best way to fulfill our role in society within the objective of building a European Education Area and contributing to the prosperity of Europe. We want to continue encouraging the participation of our students in all educational areas and continuity in professional development of our teaching staff.

Among our objectives are to improve the quality and accessibility of students with fewer mobility opportunities, promote language learning, create a sense of belonging and European citizenship based on understanding and respect for democratic rights, foster tolerance and respect for other towns and other cultures and promote sustainable practices and activities that educate in the protection of the environment.

Our institution wishes to continue participating in the different Erasmus+ actions that allow the mobility of our students and teaching staff.. To this end, there will be an Erasmus Team responsible for the development of each mobility project and whose main responsibility will be to guarantee equal opportunities with special attention to inclusion.



The Erasmus team at IES Antonio Serna Serna will be in charge of the administration and management of the projects and presentation of reports. They will implement the project by carrying out actions and monitoring all the necessary tasks before, during and after the mobility. It will publish all mobility calls in advance and will collect and evaluate, if necessary, all requests for participation. This application period will be accompanied by informative meetings in order to offer clear, practical and useful support to promote participation in Erasmus+ mobilities.

The call for participation in student and staff mobility will respect the principles of non-discrimination, transparency and inclusion. It will include an application form in an established deadline and the list of selected candidates will be published on the dates mentioned in the call.

The mobility of students to carry out training internships in companies in the European Union in the field of Higher Education will be for a period of no less than two months and the period will begin from the second half of March. The Erasmus mobility period is part of their study plan in the "Training in Work Centers" module. Selected students will have access to learning the language of the destination country through the OLS online platform.

The Erasmus Program allows students to gain work experience abroad and our teaching staff to develop their professional, linguistic, digital and cultural skills. The main objectives will be to provide continuity and increase the number and quality of student and staff mobilities without forgetting that the institutions with which we cooperate are very welcome and we are willing to host incoming students and teachers on mobilities for training and teaching.
